CRITERIA FOR FILING OF NOMINATIONS

The nominee should fulfill the below mentioned criteria. Hershey should be -

1. Good communicator
2. Empathetic
3. Someone who upholds the school prestige and honour
4. Self-disciplined
5. Responsible
6. Respectful towards Teachers, seniors and peers
7. Tolerant
8. Compassionate
9. Punctual
10. Hard working and Sincere

Please note-

- The Nomination form is to be collected from the respective Class Teacher on **Thursday 15 June 2023**.
- Completed nomination forms are to be submitted to the class teacher/section in-charge on **Friday, 16 June 2023 during Assembly/Lunch Break**.
- It has to be taken into notice that one Student can contest for only **ONE** post.
- Candidates will be selected based on their responses in the nomination form and teachers' feedback. The list of selected candidates will be displayed on all the floors on **Monday 19 June 2023**.
- These candidates will have to undergo an **interview process** by a panel headed by the Campus Head, Principal and Academic in charges from **Tuesday, 20 June to Friday 23 June 2023**.
- Based on the result of the interview, the names of the shortlisted candidates for the election will be displayed on all floors on **Monday, 26 June 2023**.
- These shortlisted candidates will campaign from **27 June – 28 June 2023**. A detailed schedule for campaigning will be shared later. All shortlisted candidates will choose a symbol for campaigning and adhere to the model code of conduct in and outside the school while campaigning. (Refer to **Model Code of Conduct on page 3**)

Any breach of Model Code of Conduct will lead to disqualification of their candidature.

- Elections for Grades 9 and 10 will be conducted on Friday, 30 June 2023.
- The **STUDENT COUNCIL** for 2023-24 will be declared on 4 July 2023.

MODEL CODE OF CONDUCT

1. The contesting candidate and their campaigners must respect the code of conduct in all circumstances, both within and outside the school premises.
2. No candidate shall engage in any activity that may exacerbate differences, create mutual hatred, or cause tension.
3. Candidates shall refrain from criticizing other candidates in any aspect.
4. Candidates will utilize appropriate language and symbols for their campaign.
5. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal sentiments to secure votes.
6. Candidates shall ensure that their supporters do not obstruct or disrupt meetings of other candidates.
7. Posters issued by one candidate shall not be defaced or removed by supporters of other candidates.
8. Canvassing during assembly, short breaks, and long breaks is not permitted.
9. Candidates must adhere to the time slots provided by the in charges for canvassing.
10. Canvassing should cease on June 28, 2023.
11. On polling day, all candidates should cooperate with the polling officials at the polling booth to ensure an orderly process. Candidates must not display their voting symbols in the vicinity of the polling booths on the polling day.
